1. Entry Day - Wednesday, August 20.
2. Judging Day - Thursday, August 21, at 9:00 a.m.
3. Release Day - Sunday, August 24, after 6:00 p.m.
4. Stall Rent - A stall rent of \$1.00 per animal and a manure fee of \$2.00 per animal will be charged, paid at the time of registration.
5. Rules and Regulations are listed in the front of the Fair Book for All Open Class entries.
6. All exhibitors of animals 3 years old and over in any of the procreative classes of this department must produce evidence, if asked, indicating the animals are not barren.
7. Breeding cows must have produced a living calf within two years preceding the day of exhibit.
8. All animals must be registered in name of exhibitor or farm name and certificate of registry presented to the Superintendents. The Registered Holstein Ancestry (RHA) must be 87% or higher to show in the Black and White Holstein Classes.
9. Only one prize in group or herd classes to one exhibitor. No more than two entries per entry number may receive premiums in individual classes.
10. All decorations must fit on the 11-12 inch furnished boards, they cannot be any wider than the boards.
11. State Regulations prohibit the sale of milk for human consumption that is produced other than in proper facilities. The Dairy Cattle Exhibitors have voted that the proceeds from the sale of milk produced at the Fair be used to improve the dairy facilities. Thank you for your cooperation.
12. Health Regulations: Any required health certificate/copy must remain in the Expo Office for the duration of the Fair. See Front of Exhibitor Handbook. It is suggested that at least 30 days prior to the Manitowoc County Fair, all dairy animals receive a 9-way and a Pastuerella vaccination. The 9-way vaccine may be administered as either a modified live (one injection needed) or a killed vaccine (initial injection followed two-four weeks later with a booster). Modified live vaccines should be used on non-pregnant animals only. Be sure to consult your veterinarian.
- 13. IF REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE NOT PRESENTED TO THE DAIRY SUPERINTENDENT BY 5:00 P.M., WEDNESDAY (ENTRY DAY) THE ANIMAL WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE SHOWN.**
14. Red & White Holsteins must be registered in Red & White Association.
15. Animals exhibited in the Jr. Fair Show cannot be shown in Open Class group classes.
16. **Touch up clipping only in stall area.**

AGE CLASSIFICATIONS:

SPRING CALF - Born between March 1, 2008 and April 15, 2008.

WINTER CALF - Born between December 1, 2007 and February 28, 2008

FALL CALF - Born between September 1, 2007 and November 30, 2007.

SUMMER YEARLING - Born between June 1, 2007 and August 31, 2007.

SPRING YEARLING - Born between March 1, 2007 and May 31, 2007.

WINTER YEARLING - Born between December 1, 2006 and February 28, 2007.

FALL YEARLING - Born between September 1, 2006 and November 30, 2006. (Senior yearlings that have calved must be shown in the 2-year-old class.)

TWO-YEAR-OLD - Born between September 1, 2005 and August 31, 2006.

THREE -YEAR-OLD - Born between September 1, 2004, and August 31, 2005.

FOUR-YEAR OLD - Born between September 1, 2003 and August , 31, 2004.

FIVE-YEAR-OLD & OVER - Born before August 31, 2003.

DRY COW 2 YEARS & OVER - Born before September 1, 2006, must have milked 280 days or more or be shown as dry on DHIA test sheet.

JR. GET-OF-SIRE - 3 animals under 2 years old, not more than one bull, from the same sire.

PRODUCE OF DAM - 2 animals either sex, any age, the produce of one cow.

SR. GET-OR-SIRE - 3 animals all over 2 years old, not more than one bull, from the same sire. Animals need not be owned by a single exhibitor.

THREE BEST FEMALES - Any age, all bred and owned by exhibitor.

All Exhibitors in this department must call the Superintendent by no later than the Monday prior to the County Fair (August 11, 2008) with the number of animals they will be bringing. If Exhibitor is Over/Under of the called in amount by more than one animal there will be a penalty of not exhibiting at the next County Fair.
