DRAFT HORSES

1. Entry Day - Friday, August 22, from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
2. Judging Day - Saturday, August 23, at 9:00 a.m. Draft Horse. Light horse starting not before 10:30 a.m.
3. Release Day – Sunday, August 24, after 6:00 p.m. Horses leaving sooner will forfeit all premiums.
4. Stall Rent - A \$1.50 per animal entry fee and a manure fee of \$2.00 per animal fee will be charged, paid at time of registration.
5. Rules and Regulations are listed in the front of the Exhibitors handbook for all Open Class entries.
6. Exhibitors must be legal residents of Manitowoc County.
7. Horses must be owned by exhibitor on entry blank and can be shown by the exhibitor or a **member of the family** residing in Manitowoc County.
8. **Family member consisting of: Husband, wife, son, daughter, step-son, step-daughter.**
9. No more than 1 animal may be shown in each lot number by one exhibitor.
10. Two premiums can be awarded one exhibitor in individual entries, but only one premium in group classes.
11. Registered animals must have papers and be shown to superintendent at time of entry at fair!
12. Champion ribbons will not be awarded where there is no competition.
13. Health Regulations - See Front of Exhibitor Handbook. **All horses must have their Coggins papers (Neg. EIA test result) checked by the superintendent before unloading their horse.**
13. Hard-soled shoes or boots are required
14. Stallions over 1 year old as of January 1, handler must be 18 years old and over, NO EXCEPTIONS.
15. Exhibitors may enter other classes in which they are eligible for ribbon only. Identify on registration form by putting the class letter behind the lot number.
16. S.E.I. approved safety helmet must be worn in ring by anybody under 18 years old.
17. Classes will run in numerical order, not the order listed in the fair book.
18. Jr. Horse: 2 years and under.
19. Sr. Horse: 3 years and over.
20. Tack stalls when available.
21. A Yield Mare is an aged mare that had no foal in the current year of if she had a foal, it did not live past 30 days.
22. No leased horses, registration papers must be shown at time of entry.
23. No dogs allowed on the grounds, unless on a leash for exhibit, presentation or handicapped.
24. Single Draft horse with cart for men and Single Draft horse cart for women must be a different animal.
25. **Animal must be identified by name on the entry form at time of entry. Failure to identify will eliminate the entry.**
26. **CLASS LIST AND EXHIBITOR NUMBERS WILL BE HANDED OUT WHEN HORSES ARE CHECKED IN.**
27. **HORSES MUST BE LOADED AND UNLOADED TO THE EAST OF THE ARENA BEHIND THE BARN.S.NO UNLOADING OR LOADING HORSES IN THE FRONT OF THE BARN.S.**
28. All horses will be assigned a stall in the horse barns, or if the number of entries warrant so, in a tent.
29. All stalls must be cleaned Sunday, August 26 or exhibitor forfeits all premiums.
30. **Only one (1) person on an entry blank.**
31. **Any horse out of its stall must be attended at all times.**

All Exhibitors in this department must call the Superintendent by no later than the Monday prior to the County Fair **(August 11, 2008)** with the number of animals they will be bringing. If Exhibitor is Over/Under of the called in amount by more than one animal there will be a penalty of not exhibiting at the next County Fair.
