

JUNIOR FAIR DOGS

Department 9

1. To be eligible the dog must be 6 months old, either purebred or a mixed breed. Crates & cages in designated areas only!
2. All dog exhibits must be the result of a regular dog project work. Each member must have trained the dog which he enters during the current year. No changes will be allowed after the blanks are submitted.
3. Dogs shall wear a slip collar and shall be led with a leather or fabric lead 6 feet long. (No prong collars or halti training aids allowed) Dogs will not be permitted off lead except when being judged. Exhibitors must keep dogs under control at all times. Showmanship lead (or show collar with show leash) must be used in all Showmanship Classes.
4. All dogs are required to have had distemper, parvo and rabies inoculations before being allowed to enter the Fair.
5. Female dogs in season will not be permitted to enter the ring, exhibitors should report to the ring alone and you will be judged separately.
6. Two entries per animal except Agility, Brace & Team for which no premiums will be paid.
7. Individual conference judging will be on Tuesday, August 19, at 5:15 p.m. in Ice Arena. Check-in time 5:00 with Showmanship judging starting at 5:15, followed by Obedience in that order. Agility will be judged from 5:15 until 7:15 p.m.
8. Dogs winning a first blue in their obedience class the previous year must show in a class higher this year.
(Example - the dog wins a first blue in pre-novice last year must show in novice this year).
9. Individuals winning a 1st blue in showmanship grades 5 and over must show in the Open Showmanship Class

102. Pre-novice B (grades 3 - 6 only)

Exhibitor has previous Experience in training a dog but is now training an untrained dog or the dog has been trained before but the handler has not or both have been trained before. Class to be judged the same as Pre-Novice A.

103. Pre-novice B (grades 7 & over)

Exhibitor has previous experience in training a dog but is now training an untrained dog or the dog has been trained before but the handler has not or both have been trained before. Class to be judged the same as Pre-novice A.
