

JUNIOR FAIR SWINE

Department 3

1. Entry Day - Monday, August 18, anytime after 12:00 p.m. Must be penned by 2:00 p.m. scanning to follow.
2. Judging Day - Tuesday, August 19, starting at 12:00 p.m. in the Walters Building.
3. Release Day - Sunday, August 24, starting at 6:00 p.m.
4. Pens will be assigned by the Junior Fair Swine Superintendent. All exhibitors must show with the youth organizations whose leader approved the entry.
5. Each exhibitor must care for and feed the animal or make arrangements to have it fed.
6. No changes will be allowed after blanks are submitted.
7. After final weigh-in swine will be divided into weight classes, with a maximum of 12 animals in one class.
8. Champion Ribbons and/or Trophies will not be awarded unless there is competition.
9. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** See front of fairbook and any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during Fair.
10. Exhibitors must show their own animals. If assistance is needed, it will be provided by the ring help.
11. **JR. FAIR EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR THE EXHIBITOR NUMBERED HAT/HARNESS WHILE SHOWING. FAILURE TO WEAR THE EXHIBITOR NUMBER WILL RESULT IN PREMIUM MONEY FORFEITURE!!!**

CLASS B: SHOWMANSHIP (Danish Judging)

Pink Ribbon - \$1.50

First Blue Ribbon Winners from previous fairs are not eligible to compete in the same age division.

CLASS C: HERDSMANSHIP

Herdsmanship awards will be made in two groups divided according to the number of animals exhibited. All clubs are automatically entered.

HERDSMANSHIP SCORE CARD

Preparation of Exhibit – 40 point

Exhibitors – 30 points

Care of Exhibit – 30 points

1. Clubs cannot use decorations wider than the 11-12 inch boards that are furnished.

2. Consideration will be given to maturity of animals in the exhibit
A traveling herdsmanship trophy will be awarded to the 1st place winner in each group. The trophies and ribbons will be presented on Sunday afternoon following the Parade of Champions.

If an organization is awarded the trophy for three (3) consecutive years, the organization is permanently awarded the trophy.
