**Rules:**

- 1 \$20 exhibitor ticket due by July 31 includes unlimited entries. Horses must stay in barn from Friday Aug. 28 through Sunday Aug. 30. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 2 Trailer-ins allowed. Trailers must park to the East of the horse arena. \$10 admission includes 1 free class. All additional classes \$3.00 per class per horse.
- 3 Stalls will be first come first serve, determined by post mark date on entry blank.
- 4 Tack stalls when available.
- 5 Classes may be entered up to two classes prior to the class being entered.
- 6 Pre-entries accepted & encouraged; all horses staying in stalls MUST be pre-registered by Aug. 7, 2009.
- 7 English Type are horses with Arabian, Saddlebred, Morgan, etc. breeding
- 8 Western Type are horses with Quarter Horse, Paint, Appaloosa, etc. breeding.
- 9 Leased horses may be shown.
- 10 Trailer-ins must be removed from the grounds by 4:30 pm on Saturday Aug. 29. All trailers not removed will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- 11 SEI approved safety helmets are required for all youth under 18. Use is recommended for all others.
- 12 Stallion handlers MUST be 18 years old or over. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 13 Negative Coggins from 2009 and Premise ID number are needed before horses are unloaded on fairgrounds
- 14 No dogs allowed on the grounds.

- 16 Only trucks with horses in trailers may enter at Merchant's gate. All others to use general parking.
