1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – **Monday, August 23**, as follows: 10am to 2pm, and 2:30pm to 6pm.
2. Release Day – **Sunday, August 29**, between 7pm and 9pm.
3. No changes will be allowed after the registration forms are submitted.
4. Bulletin boards, wall hangings, and pictures must be suitable for hanging.
5. Kits are pre-packaged and include all materials.
6. Prepare to discuss in which room the article will be placed.
7. Exhibitor must stay in one (1) class. Limit of four (4) entries per exhibitor, one (1) entry per lot number.
8. All “any other” entries must be named on the registration form and entry tag.
9. Entry tags must be attached to all items entered.
10. Pictures may be used for posters and scrapbooks.
