JUNIOR FAIR SHEEP

1. Entry Day – **Monday, August 23**, between 12pm and 2pm. Must be penned by 2pm, scanning to follow.
2. Judging Day – **Tuesday, August 24**, starting at 3pm, in the Walters Building.
3. Release Day – **Sunday, August 29**, starting at 6pm.
4. Pens will be assigned by the Junior Fair Swine Superintendent. All exhibitors must show with the youth organization whose leader approved the entry.
5. Each exhibitor must care for and feed the animal or make arrangements to have the animal fed and cared for and cleaned.
6. An animal can be entered in one (1) class only. No changes will be allowed after registration forms are submitted.
7. After final weigh-in, sheep will be divided by market wethers and market ewes and shown in two separate lot numbers with three (3) weight classes: Light-Medium-Heavy, with a maximum of twelve (12) animals in one (1) class.
8. A champion and reserve champion market wether and ewe will be chosen by the judge. The champion and reserve champion market wether and ewe will compete against each other for overall grand and reserve grand champion sheep awards.
9. Champion Ribbons and/or trophies will not be awarded unless there is competition.
10. All market sheep – Must be shorn 7-10 days prior to show date at the Fair. All Class N Market Lamb entries must be shorn 7-10 days prior to show date of the fair.
11. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** See WI County, District, & State Fairs 2010 Animal Health Rules and Regulations located on the Web site. Any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during the fair.
12. Exhibitors must show their own animals. If assistance is needed, it will be provided by the ring help.
13. **JUNIOR FAIR EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR THEIR EXHIBITOR NUMBERED HAT/HARNESS WHILE SHOWING. FAILURE TO WEAR THE EXHIBITOR NUMBER WILL RESULT IN PREMIUM MONEY FORFEITURE!**

1. Clubs cannot use decorations wider than 11-12 inch boards that are furnished.
2. Consideration will be given to maturity of animals in the exhibit. A traveling herdsmanship trophy will be awarded to the First Place Winner in each group. The trophies and ribbons will be presented on Sunday afternoon following the Parade of Champions. If an organization is awarded the trophy for three (3) consecutive years, the organization is permanently awarded the trophy.
