



2011 CEDAR PLANTER GUIDELINES

1. Size of planter: 15 to 18 inches.
2. Soil, plants, flowers and any other materials you wish to use is your responsibility.
3. Decorate the planters. Be creative and be sure to have your club's name displayed (ex: a wooden sign placed in the planter, wood burn your club's name on the planter, etc.).
4. Be sure your club's name is written on the bottom of the planter.
5. Bring planters to the north end of Exhibition Building on Sunday, **August 21, 2011**, from noon to 4:00 pm or Monday, **August 22, 2011** by 5pm.
6. Planters will be judged in the following categories: Fair Theme, Fair Colors, Most eye appealing, Most Colorful, Most Creative, Identification of club, Silliest, Most unusual, People's Choice, Nursery Rhyme and Cartoon.
7. Planters will be placed throughout the fair grounds.
8. Release of planters will be Sunday, **August 28, 2011**, at the north end of the Exhibition Building from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. or may be picked up on Monday, **August 29, 2011**.
9. Planters will need to be checked and watered by the participating 4-H club. Please designate someone from your club to care for the planter during fair week.

*The cedar planters can be stored at the Expo during winter if you wish

*Thought – If you place Styrofoam peanuts in the bottom half of the planter, it will not be as heavy as using all soil

***The County Fair Theme: 2011 Manitowoc County Fair – Ribbons, Rides and Rock N' Roll**

***Fair colors: Red, White, and Blue**
