1. Entry Day – All entries must be brought in **Friday, August 26**, and taken home after judging.
2. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – **Friday, August 26**, beginning at 5pm in the Lester's Building Show Ring. We will begin with the caged birds, other small animals, & cats, from the blue winning cats and kittens, a Grand & Reserve Champion will be selected.
3. All entries must be shown by the exhibitor.
4. All entries **MUST BE** under control at all times. Cats/kittens **MUST** have collar or harness and be on a leash. Also have nails trimmed, if they have any.
5. All cats and kittens must be vaccinated for distemper and rabies. Distemper and rabies inoculations must have been administered with the past year and at least two (2) weeks before the day of the exhibit. Certificates must reflect a 1/2/3rd year shot or booster. Show your certificates before judging starts.
6. Exhibitor must show proof of inoculation before judging begins.
7. Four (4) live exhibits may be shown in each class. One (1) entry per lot number.
8. Bring entry tag.
9. All Animals must be in a carrier, including cats and kittens.
10. No Male Cats over eight (8) months non-altered.
11. No animals for sale or to be given away during the fair.
