1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – **Monday, August 22**, as follows: 10am to 2pm, and 2:30pm to 6pm.
2. Release Day – **Sunday, August 28**, between 7pm and 9pm.
3. No changes will be allowed after the registration forms are submitted.
4. Each exhibitor may enter four (4) articles of Clothing, plus two (2) more articles under the Clothing Revue project.
5. All “any other” entries must be listed on the registration form.
6. Use safety pins to secure garments and belts on hangers.
7. Bring all garments on wire hangers **only**.
8. Garments will be accepted for exhibit only if they are clean and pressed and entry tags attached with a safety pin to the left shoulder of the garment.
9. All poster boards must be white. All of the poster items must be sewn.
10. Garments may be of any fabric which is appropriate for the member, the pattern, and the occasion.
11. All exhibitors must be prepared to talk to the Judge on the following information: Fiber content, intended use, intended care, type of interfacing used if interfacing is necessary, and preparation of findings.

Lot Numbers:

149. Body Poster – use colors to compliment the poster of the Exhibitor as well as lines to enhance the body.
150. Draw a color wheel with colors to enhance the wardrobe. In the center of the wheel write description of exhibitor – hair, eyes, skin, etc.
151. Suitcase Survival – include a sheet describing a real or imaginary trip with Exhibitor's wardrobe coordinated to the activities. Pack a suitcase for this trip showing use of space.

155. Poster showing stain removal chart with swatches of what used and outcome.

CLOTHING REVUE

1. Judging Day (Individual Conference Judging) – **Thursday, June 16, at 6pm, at the Manitowoc County Office Complex.**
2. Garments entered in Clothing Revue may not be entered elsewhere.
3. Exhibitors may enter two (2) articles of clothing in Clothing Revue.
4. No changes will be allowed after registration forms are submitted.
5. Exhibitors must model the garment at a predetermined day during the fair.
6. Bring all garments on wire hangers **only**.
7. Use safety pins to attach garments and belts to hanger.
8. Entry tags must be attached with a safety pin to the top left side of the garment.
