1. Entry Day – **Tuesday, August 23**, from 9am-7pm.
2. Judging Day – **Wednesday, August 24**, starting at 9am.
3. Release Day – **Thursday, August 25**, starting at 6pm. Horses and ponies are eligible to stay in the barns until 10am, Friday morning.
4. Stalls will be assigned by the Junior Fair Horse Superintendent. All exhibitors must show with the youth organization whose leader approved the entry. **A \$2 Manure Fee will be charged for each animal entered.**
5. Each exhibitor must care for and feed the animal or make arrangements to have the animal fed and cared for.
6. No changes will be allowed after registration forms are submitted.
7. Any horse showing evidence of a contagious or infectious disease may not be exhibited at the Fair. If at any time any animal shows evidence of a contagious or infectious disease, the animal shall be immediately removed from the fairgrounds by the owner.
8. S.E.I. Approved helmet, with safety harness securely fastened, is required when riding or driving.
9. An exhibitor may exhibit no more than two (2) animals in this department, only one (1) animal per lot number.
10. **To assure a well-run show with proper awards, exhibitors must also complete a horse and pony pre-registration form. Each exhibitor must designate premium classes and ribbon only classes. Only the premium classes should be listed on the official fair entry form. Fair pre-registration forms are available online at www.manitowocountyexpo.com, in the Expo office, UW-Extension offices, and at any 4-H horse project event. No animal may be shown in more than two (2) premium classes, but may be shown in unlimited ribbon only or no premium classes.**
11. Classes will run in numerical order, not the order listed below.
12. **Horseless Horse entries MAY enter Open Walk/Trot Pleasure Classes or Walk/Trot Trail Class; however, a blue ribbon in those classes would not qualify for State 4-H Horse Expo.**
13. There will be no distinction between grades and purebreds.
14. No stallions may be exhibited except on brood mare and foal as a colt.
15. Breed date for age of animal shall be January 1.
16. A pony is 56" and under.
17. Ponies are allowed to enter in pony designated classes only.
18. All horses entered will be assigned a stall in the horse barn, or if the number of entries warrant so, in a tent.
19. **Horses must be loaded and unloaded to the East of the Arena behind the barns. NO UNLOADING OR LOADING HORSES IN FRONT OF THE BARNs.**
20. Superintendent has the right to combine classes. All changes will be posted by 5pm on **Tuesday, August 23**.
21. Class list and exhibitor numbers will be handed out when horses are checked in.
22. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** See WI County, District, & State Fairs 2011 Animal Health Rules and Regulations located on the Web site. Any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during the fair.
23. **JUNIOR FAIR EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR THEIR EXHIBITOR NUMBER WHILE SHOWING. FAILURE TO WEAR THE EXHIBITOR NUMBER WILL RESULT IN PREMIUM MONEY FORFEITURE!**
24. State 4-H Horse Show forms are due to the UW-Extension office by **Monday, August 29, 2011**.
25. **Animals must be identified by name on the entry form at time of entry. Failure to identify will eliminate the entry.**
26. **All stalls must be cleaned. Exhibitors who do not clean their stalls will forfeit all premiums.**
