1. Entry Day – **Monday, August 22**, between 12pm and 2pm. Must be penned by 2pm, scanning to follow.
2. Judging Day – **Tuesday, August 23**, starting at **8:30am**, in the Walters Building.
3. Release Day – **Sunday, August 28**, starting at **5pm**.
4. Pens will be assigned by the Junior Fair Swine Superintendent. All exhibitors must show with the youth organization whose leader approved the entry.
5. Each exhibitor must care for and feed the animal or make arrangements to have the animal fed.
6. No changes will be allowed after registration forms are submitted.
7. Only one (1) animal can be shown in each lot number.
8. After final weigh-in, swine will be divided by barrows and gilts and into three (3) weight classes: Light-Medium-Heavy, with a maximum of twelve (12) animals in one class. This will be determined by the superintendent.
9. A champion and reserve champion barrow and gilt will be chosen by the judge. The champion and reserve champion barrow and gilt will compete against each other for overall grand and reserve grand champion market hog awards.
10. Champion Ribbons and/or trophies will not be awarded unless there is competition.
11. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** See WI County, District, & State Fairs **2011** Animal Health Rules and Regulations located on the Web site. Any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during the fair.
12. Exhibitors must show their own animals. If assistance is needed, it will be provided by the ring help.
13. **JUNIOR FAIR EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR THEIR EXHIBITOR NUMBERED HAT/HARNESS WHILE SHOWING. FAILURE TO WEAR THE EXHIBITOR NUMBER WILL RESULT IN PREMIUM MONEY FORFEITURE!**

CLASS B: SHOWMANSHIP (Danish Judging)

CLASS C: HERDSMANSHIP

Herdsmanship awards will be made in two (2) groups divided according to the number of animals exhibited. All clubs are automatically entered.

HERDSMANSHIP SCORE CARD

1. Clubs cannot use decorations wider than 11-12 inch boards that are furnished.
2. Consideration will be given to maturity of animals in the exhibit. A traveling herdsmanship trophy will be awarded to the First Place Winner in each group. The trophies and ribbons will be presented on Sunday afternoon following the Parade of Champions. If an organization is awarded the trophy for three (3) consecutive years, the organization is permanently awarded the trophy.
