

PREMIUM LIST FOR THE MANITOWOC COUNTY FAIR

OPEN CLASS DIVISION

1. Fair entry registrations can be made during Expo office hours through **July 15**. Mailed entries, if necessary, should be post marked no later than **July 15**! Any questions – call 920-683-4378.
Fair tags must be picked up prior to August 12.
2. **List only 1 item under each lot number.**
3. Entry Day in Open Class will be as follows:
 - a. Sheep must be in place no later than 7pm on **Monday, August 22.**
 - b. Flowers and Plants – Entry Day, **Tuesday, August 23**, from 9am until 7pm ONLY!
 - c. Beef Cattle must be in place by **Tuesday, August 23**, no later than 3pm.
 - d. Entry day for all departments in the Exhibition Building will be **Tuesday, August 23**, before 7pm.
 - e. All **Dairy Cattle** and **Goats** must be in place by **Wednesday, August 25**, no later than 3pm, wool/fleece entries by 9am.
 - f. Entry Day for all small animals will be **Wednesday, August 24**, before 6pm.
 - g. Open Horse Show – Entry Day is **Friday, August 26**, from 10am until 7pm.
4. Release Time in Open class will be on **Sunday, August 28** as follows:
Market Sale Animals, Dairy Cattle – 5pm
Sheep, Goats, Small Animals – 5:30pm
Exhibition Building – 7pm-9pm
 - a. No dismantling of decorations until after release times.
5. All possible care will be given to prevent loss or damage to the exhibits, but no responsibility for the same will be assumed.
6. All Any Other entries in all departments must be named on the registration blank and entry tag!
7. Merit Awards will be awarded for each 100 entries in each Department. Merit Awards will be given in all non-animal divisions based on the Judges discretion.

Notice

Any exhibitor with law violations on Expo grounds during the Fair will carry a penalty of one (1) year suspension of Fair exhibiting. This is retroactive to the 1990 Fair.

MANITOWOC COUNTY FAIR EXHIBITOR HANDBOOK REVISIONS

In order to give exhibitors and groups an opportunity to revise or edit the Manitowoc County Fair Exhibitor Handbook, the Expo Board has approved the following procedure:

1. 4-H, FFA, FHA, Scouts, Pioneers, Breed Groups, or Exhibitors must identify proposed concerns or changes.
2. The group or exhibitor makes a written recommendation to the superintendent of the department when a change is desired for the next year. All suggested changes must be forwarded to the superintendent by September 1.
3. The superintendent reviews the change, checks it against the state statutes (ATCP) and forwards a recommendation to his/her liaison on the Expo Fair Board. Superintendents must forward these recommendations by November 1 of the fair year.
4. All liaison members must have these Fair Book revisions, with recommendations in writing, to the Expo office by November 1.
5. The Expo Fair Board reviews all recommendations at its November meeting.
6. The Expo Fair Board acts on the recommendations at its December meeting.
