OPEN CLASS SHEEP

1. Entry Day – **Monday, August 22**, no later than 7pm.
2. Judging Day – **Tuesday, August 23**, starting at **2:30pm**, in the Walters Building.
3. Release Day – **Sunday, August 28**, starting at **5:30pm**.
4. Pen Rent - \$2 per pen and \$1 per animal manure fee will be charged and paid at time of registration.
5. Champion ribbons will not be awarded when there is no competition.
6. No more than two (2) animals may be shown in each lot number by one (1) exhibitor or one (1) Registered Farm name.
7. Two (2) premiums can be awarded to one (1) exhibitor in individual entries, but one (1) premium in group entries.
8. Registered Columbias, Rambouillets, and Targhees shall be shown with two (2) inches of wool or less. All other breeds shall have been completely shorn not more than two (2) months or less than two (2) weeks to show date.
9. Only registered animals shall be shown in Open Class.
10. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** See WI County, District, & State Fairs **2011** Animal Health Rules and Regulations located on the Web site. Any required health certificates/copies must remain in the Expo office during the fair.

All exhibitors in this department must call the Superintendent by no later than the Monday prior to the County Fair (August 16, 2010) with the number of animals they will be bringing. If exhibitor is over/under of the called in amount by more than one (1) animal, there will be a penalty of not exhibiting at the next County Fair.

CLASS M: WOOL/SHEEP SHOW

1. Entry Day – **Tuesday, August 23, no later than 12pm.**
2. Judging Day – **Tuesday, August 23**, following Market Animal Sheep judging which begins at 3pm.
3. All fleeces must be from sheep owned by the exhibitor and shorn within the last twelve (12) months. Fleeces must be tied with paper twine.
4. all fleeces, except Champion and Reserve Champions, must be removed at the conclusion of judging. Champion and Reserve Champion Fleeces, white and natural colored, will be on display in the Exhibition Building until release time for sheep.
5. Judge may use own discretion in placing the fleece in the proper fleece category before show judging.
6. Junior Fair Exhibitors may show in the Open Class Wood Division.
